Les prépositions et les noms

To describe clothing details, one can use *prepositions* followed by nouns. Those prepositions include:

- **à** = that has...
- **de** = for...
- **en** = made of...
- **avec** = with...
- **sans** = without...

Note: Each of these prepositions is followed by a noun. The noun does not change regardless of its gender or number.

Ex: A shirt that has short sleeves	=	Une chemise à manches courtes
Some socks for soccer	=	Des chaussettes de soccer
Some shoes made of leather	=	Des chaussures en cuir
A jacket (f) with pockets	=	Une veste avec poches
A golf shirt without a logo	=	Un polo sans logo
